Situated in Abu Dhabi, the capital city of the United Arab Emirates, Al Corniche Hospital has been supporting the women of the region through pregnancy and childbirth for over 25 years. Al Corniche Hospital is a purpose-built obstetrics and gynaecology facility with 235 beds, 14 delivery suites and 50 neonatal intensive care cots. With more than 10,000 births a year, Al Corniche Hospital is the busiest maternity hospital in Abu Dhabi. There are also more than 400 outpatient visits per day.

Al Corniche has been named a "Baby Friendly" hospital which is considered the "gold standard" for Maternity Hospitals from the World Health Organisation and UNICEF.

Al Corniche Hospital received Joint Commission International accreditation in 2008. It has also been recognized for postgraduate training by the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists and the Arab Board of Medical Specializations.

Al Corniche Hospital is owned by Abu Dhabi Health Services Company (Seha) and managed by Johns Hopkins Medicine International.
