English language tests for overseas candidates - IELTS

IELTS is the International English Language Testing System. It is a test designed to determine each individual's standard in the four language skills of reading, writing, speaking and listening.

It is the requirement of the Nurses Board of Western Australia that any nurse wanting to gain registration in Western Australia and is not born and bred in Australia, UK, Ireland, USA, Canada or New Zealand must sit and successfully pass an IELTS examination with a score of at least 6.5 in reading and a score of at least 7 in writing and speaking, with an overall score of 7 for the entire examination.

It is the requirement of the NMB New South Wales that any nurse wanting to gain registration in New South Wales and is not born and bred in Australia, New Zealand, UK, Ireland, USA and some areas of Canada must sit and successfully pass an IELTS examination with a score of at least 7 in each of the four separate areas assessed. Original test results must be submitted to the NMB New South Wales and must have been within 2 years prior to the application for registration or

enrolment. Exemptions from the requirements to provide results of an English Language Test are subject to review by the NMB New South Wales on a case by case basis.

An English language test may not be required where an applicant's nursing or midwifery course was undertaken in New Zealand, Ireland, UK, USA, Australia or some areas of Canada.
